Food Safety Regulator Certification (FSRC)— This credential is the prerequisite to all other credentials. This certification can be obtained prior to employment as a Regulator and may be used as a qualification or preference in hiring in some jurisdictions. Non-regulators are eligible to complete this certification for regulatory employment purposes only.

You must be currently employed at the Local, State, Tribal, Territorial, or Federal Regulatory agency in order to take the following exams:



Food Foundations Regulator Certification (FFRC)— Must be taken **prior** to taking retail foods or manufactured foods specific certifications.



Manufactured Foods Regulator Certification (MFRC)— Requires successful completion of **FSRC** and **FFRC** for eligibility along with current employment at *Local, State, Tribal, Territorial, or Federal Regulatory agency.*



Retail Foods Regulator Certification (RFRC)— Requires successful completion of **FSRC** and **FFRC** for eligibility along with current employment at *Local, State, Tribal, Territorial, or Federal Regulatory agency.*

Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

The AFDO Annual Education Conference will help you earn Continuing Education Units (CEUs). We welcome everyone to join in this professional development experience at the conference held each June.

- The required CEU's for each specialized credential is fifteen (15) hours
 of contact time over a 36-month(3 year) period. The two specialized
 credentials are Manufactured Foods Regulator Certification (MFRC) and
 Retail Foods Regulator Certification (RFRC).
- You may use the same courses for each credential.

AFDO aligns the Manufactured Foods Regulator Certification (MFRC), Retail Foods Regulator Certification (RFRC), and your continuing education with your Agency's renewal date.

- One time only, AFDO will adjust and align your credential date to match your Agency's renewal date.
 - For example: Your certification date is June 12, 2023. Your Agency's renewal date is November 12th. AFDO will align your credential expiration to November 12th giving you 41 months to earn required CEUs instead of 36 months.
- You <u>must</u> know your agency's renewal date for:
 - Manufactured Foods -- it is your Agency's Audit Date
 - Retail Foods -- it is your Agency's Standardization Date
- As shown below, when completing your AFDO Credential application this is where you enter "your Agency's renewal date" or "N/A".

Proctoring Opportunities

Live+ Proctoring

Live+ proctoring is virtual proctoring that uses strict security protocols, advanced software, and human oversight to create the right testing environment.

 Live+ proctoring prevents cheating with continuous session monitoring and ensures an equitable experience for each examinee.

Live + What you can expect?

- 1. Through the secure Guardian browser examinees connect to their proctoring session.
- 2. Guardian secures the virtual environment by locking down each test-taker's computer according to settings configured by exam administrators.
- **3.** The exam begins with a Live Proctor who guides the examinees through the exam launch, multifactor identity verification, and an environment security scan. The scan ensures unpermitted materials can be removed before the exam begins.
- **4.** The live proctor will remain with you during the exam.

Live + Best Practices

- Be on time for your proctored exam session.
- Follow the Live+ rescheduling policy to avoid additional charges.
- You will need to **use your cell phone** and show the live proctor **in realtime a panoramic view of your computer and the surrounding area** including under your desk or table, over, up, down, and all around.
- If testing at home, pick an area of your home that is:
 - o **clear** of books, notes, papers, signs; as well as
 - o **quiet** and free of other people, children, and pets.
- The room and your computer area should be **free of clutter**. A conference room, library, or meeting room is ideal.

In-person Proctoring

In-person Proctoring is made available at educational conferences, training sessions, meetings, conventions, and agency in-service days. There is an additional cost for In-person proctoring and travel expenses will apply.
